

Introduction:

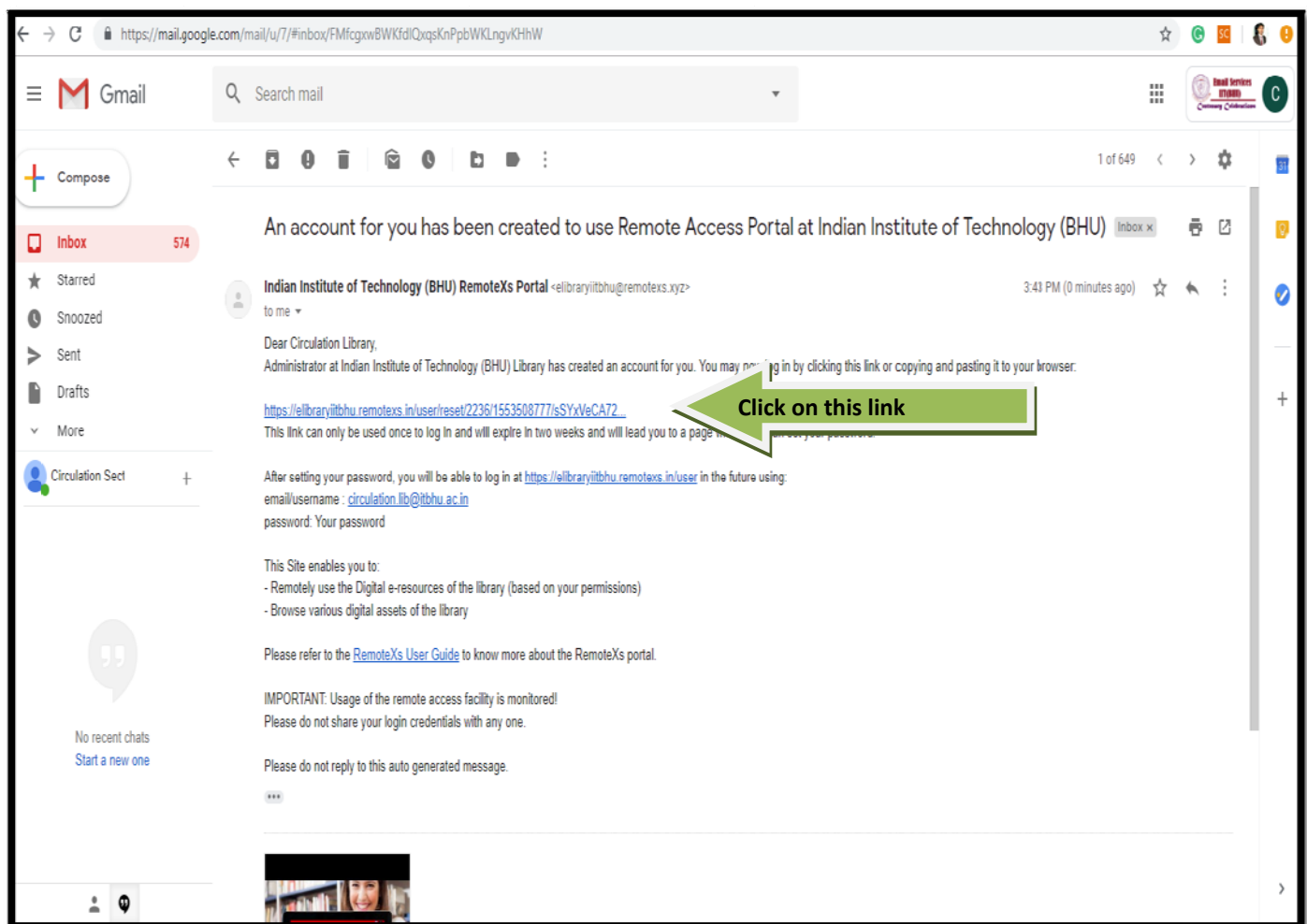
RemoteXs has enabled all leading institutions (academic or research) in optimizing usage of the precious e-Resources and nurturing research interests of faculty and their students.

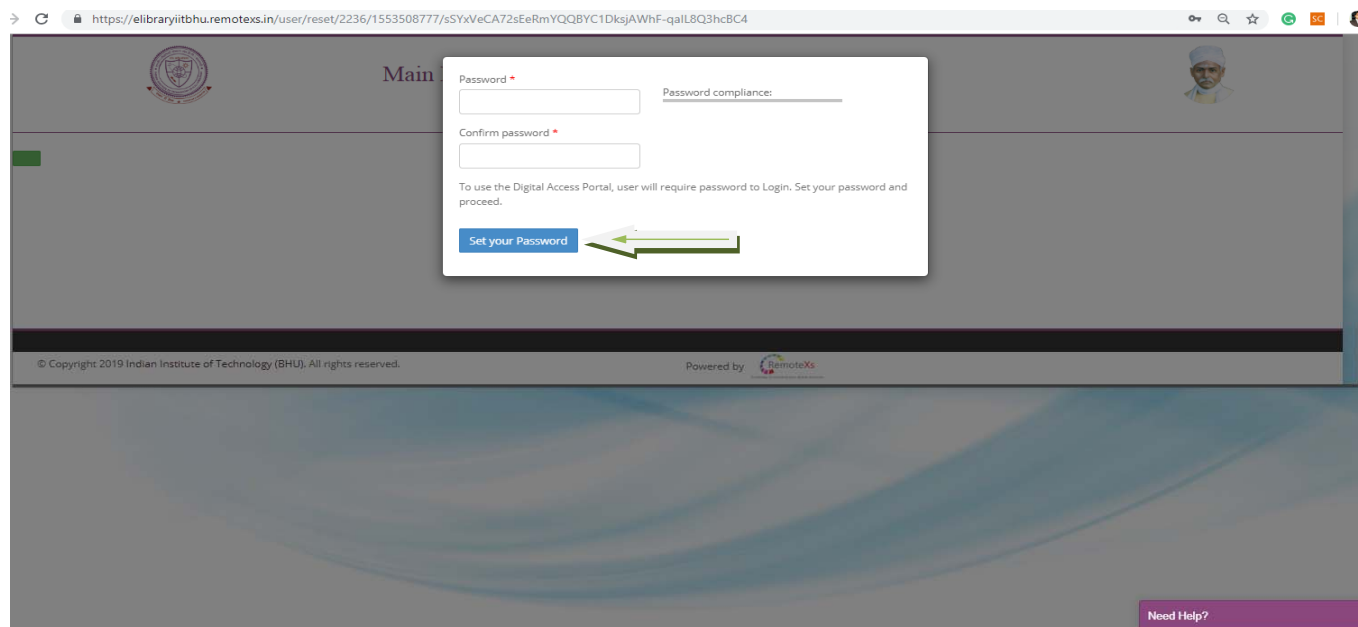
Create an Account:

Step 1: Login to your **Institutional emails ID** and open the welcome email received from **Indian Institute of Technology (BHU) RemoteXs Portal**.

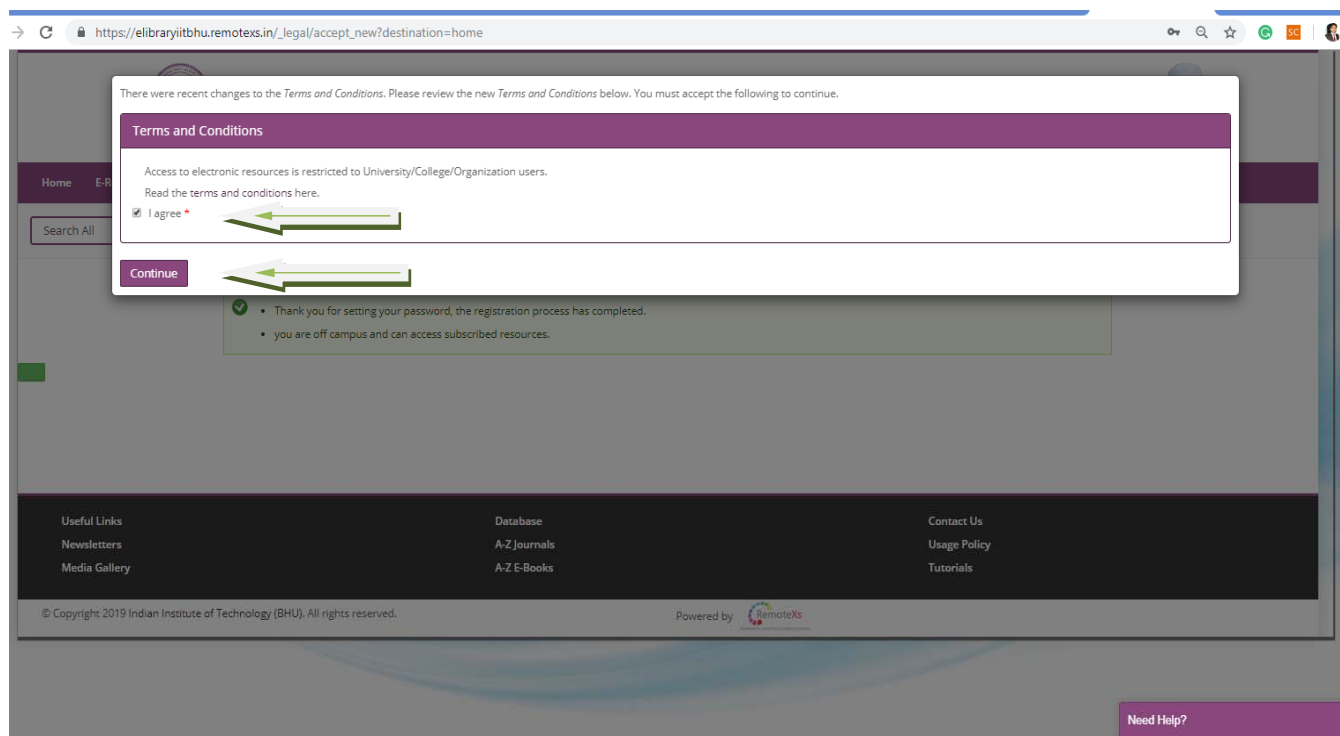
Step 2: Kindly follow the steps provided in the email and **click on the link**.



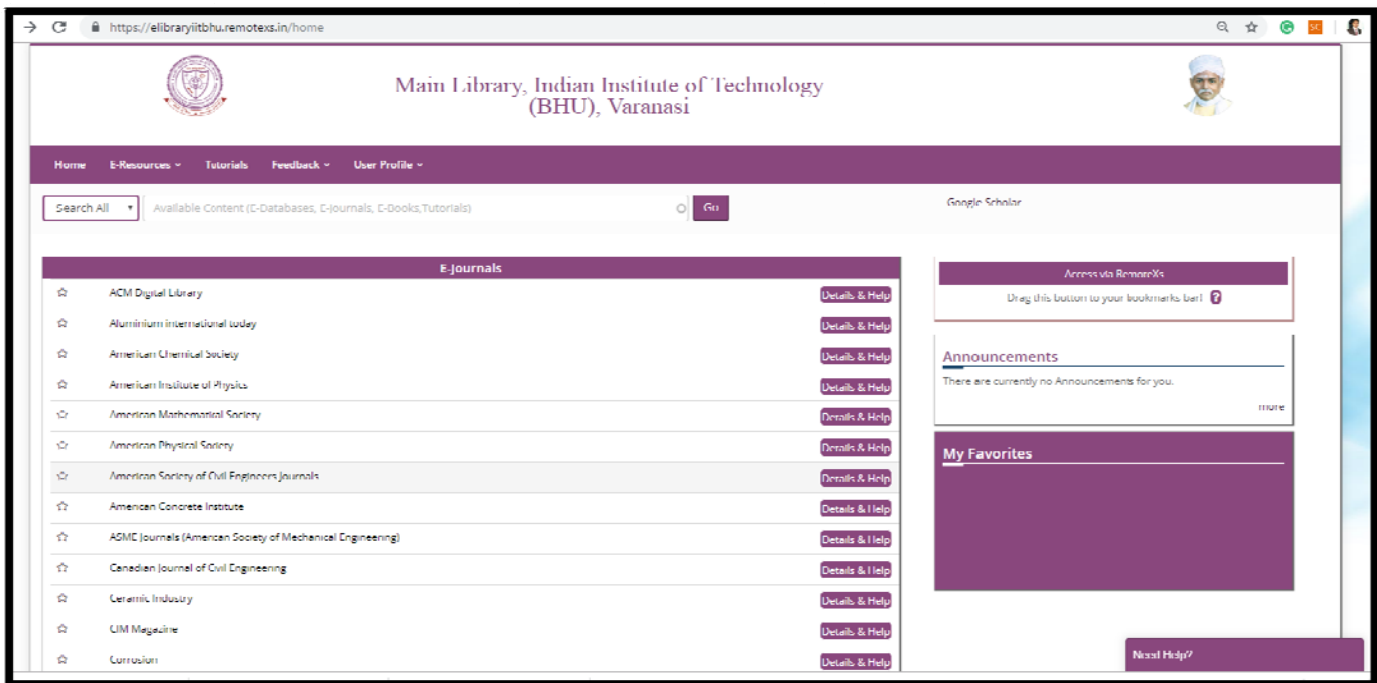
Step 3: Set your Password (Minimum 8 characters required Capital, Small, Number & Special) after that click on **Set your Password**.



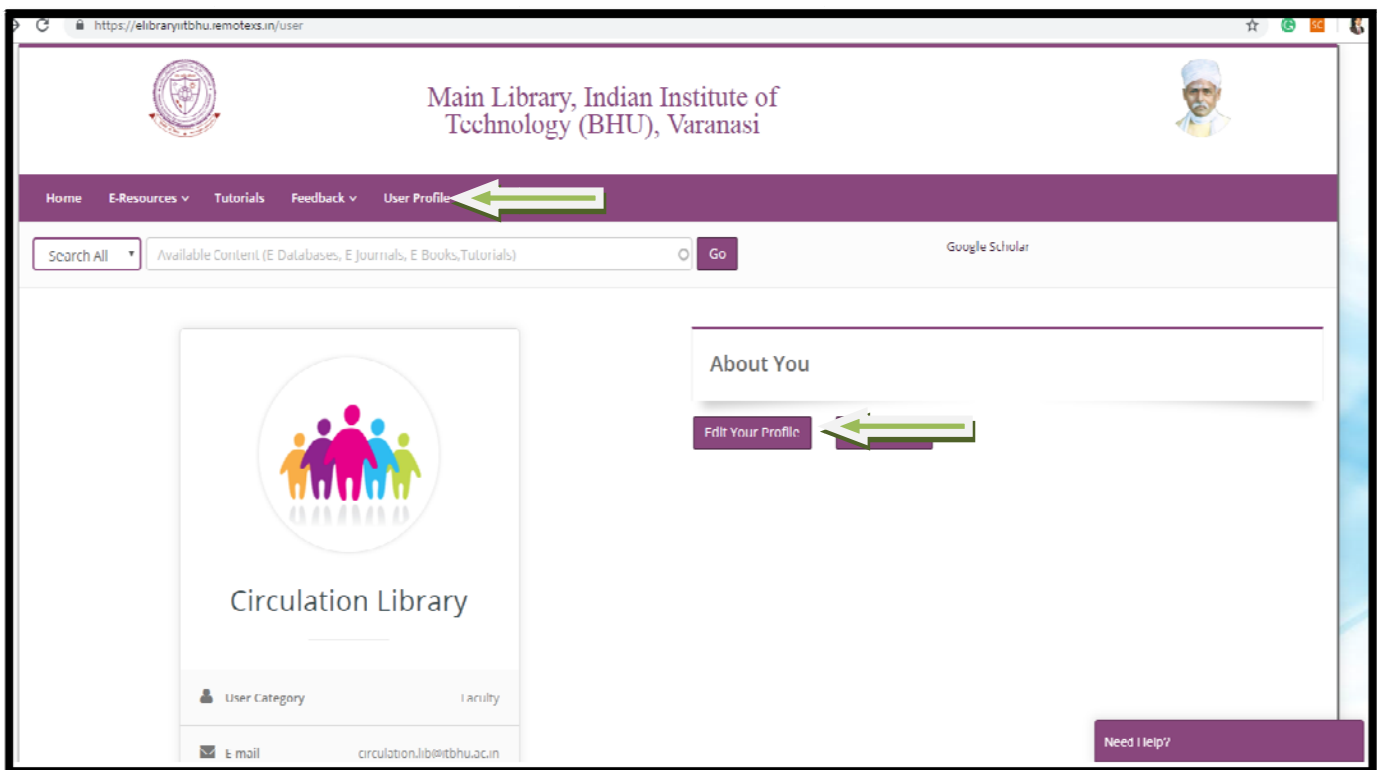
Step 4: Tick the box of **"I agree"** and click to **continue**.



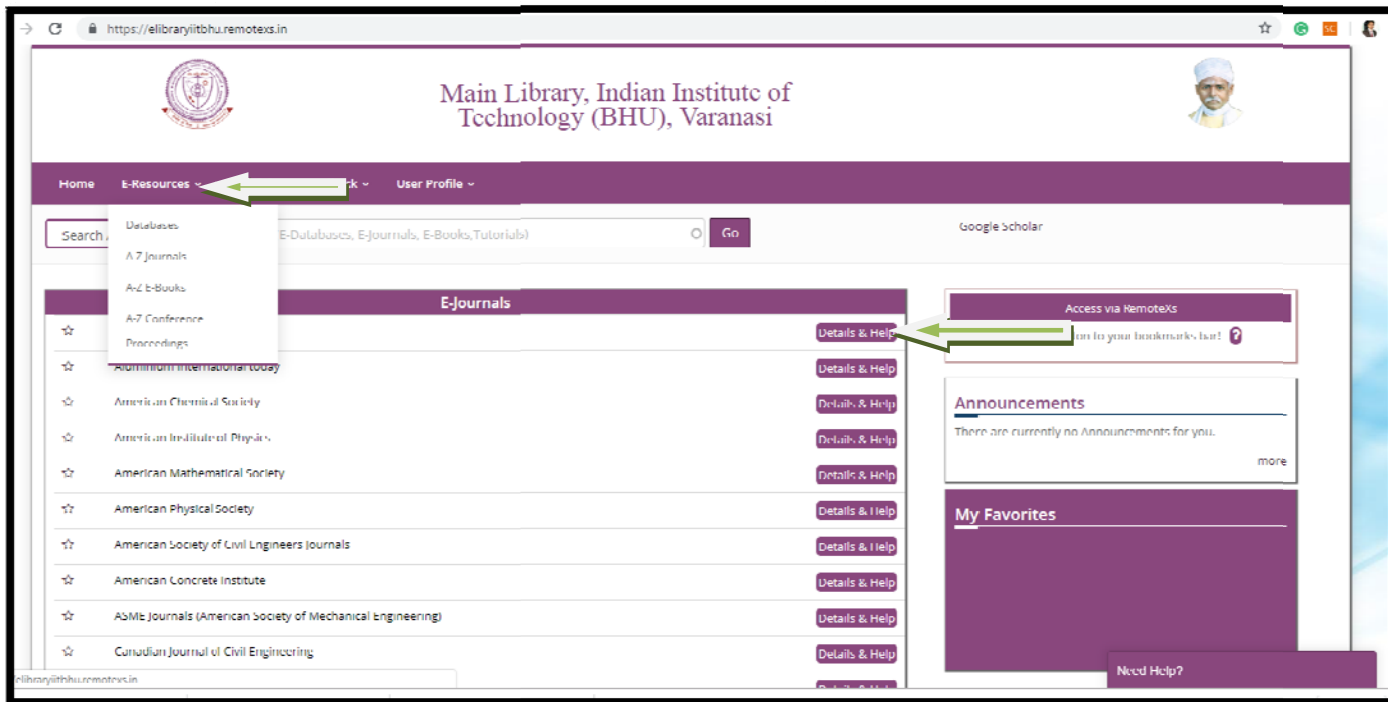
Step 5: Registration completed, now you can access and explore the portal.



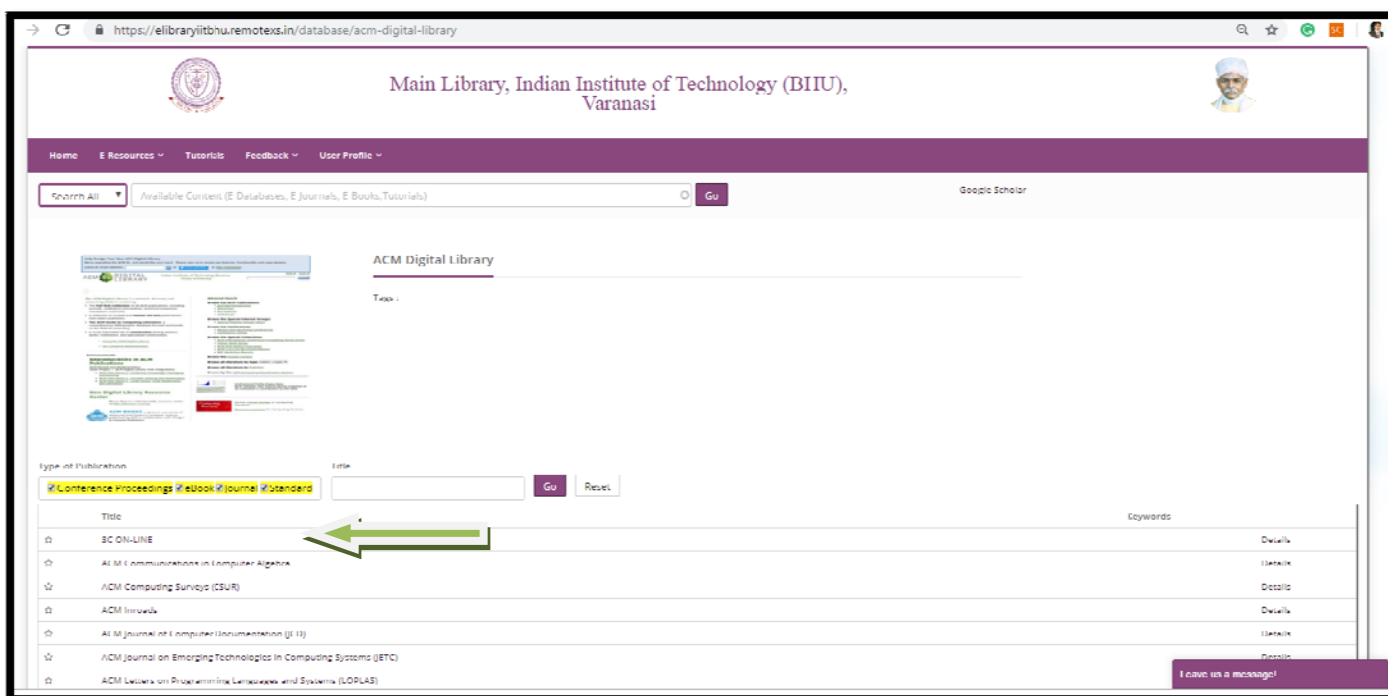
Step 7: To edit and update your profile click on **User Profile** after that click on **Edit your profile**.



Step 8: For all resources subscribed by the Main Library, IIT (BHU), Varanasi Click on the **E-Resources** (Databases, A-Z Journal, e-books, e-Standards etc.). For more details of each title click on the **Details & Help**.

How to create a Remote access user account?

For Remote access user account forward a request letter through Head of the department to Deputy Librarian, Main Library, IIT (BHU), Varanasi. Note that letter should contain Name, Designation, Staff ID/student ID, Institutional email ID & Mobile Number.

Usage Policy for Authorized Users of Subscribed Electronic Resources of Indian Institute of Technology (BHU), Varanasi-

The Indian Institute of Technology (BHU) Library subscribes electronic databases of academic interest to support the academic activities of the Institute students, faculty and staff. These resources are purchased/subscribed by the Institute either directly from the publisher or through consortia. These are also governed by license and contract agreements. Each electronic resource whether purchased individually or through consortia contains strict guidelines on the use of resources by authorized users.

- Authorized Users are individuals who are affiliated to the organization by way of employment or students/scholars of an institution.
- Individuals should use these resources for personal study or research purpose
- Modification of learning resources available on electronic databases is prohibited.
- Authorized users should not use the articles/documents of these electronic resources for the commercial purpose. Wherever these articles/documents are used due credit of copyright should be given to the source.
- Downloading resources through automatic programs or speed boosters is strictly prohibited.
- Distributing these resources through photocopies, printouts for purposes other than academic interest or sharing one's individual access details is strictly prohibited.
- Mounting or distributing any part of the licensed material on any electronic network, including the Internet and the World Wide Web, other than the Secure Network (a network which is only accessible to "authorized users" whose conduct shall be subjected to regulation by the licensee) is prohibited.
- Individual publishers have their discretion to terminate the license for the use of their resources on violation of any of the above instructions.
